Terms and conditions

Confirmation

Wedding photography is not considered confirmed until Sydney Harbour Foreshore Authority (the Authority) is in receipt of a holding deposit of \$110.

Payment schedule

Upon booking request approval, the Authority requires the holding deposit within 24 hours. Final payment is required fourteen (14) days prior to the date of the wedding photography. If payment is not received, the booking may be cancelled and the deposit withheld.

Cancellation by the client

All cancellations must be in writing.

Cancellations will be subject to the following:

- For notice of cancellation outside of six (6) months prior to the date of the event 50 percent of the deposit will be refunded to the client.
- For notice of cancellation within six (6) months prior to the date of the event, the client will forfeit the deposit.

Hours for hire

Wedding photography is available from 10am – 5pm; last booking 3pm.

Essential information for clients

- Permission from the Authority is required for proposed decorative enhancements.
- The Chinese Garden forecourt is a pedestrian precinct; no vehicles are permitted at any time
- Paid parking is available nearby.
- Colonnades and pathways must be minimally disrupted.
- Pavilions cannot be used exclusively.

Prohibited

- The use of rice, rose petals and confetti
- Bringing food and beverages into the garden
- Walking on the garden beds
- Touching the water features and pond
- Bringing pets or other animals into the garden (Assistance Dogs excepted)
- The use of candles and other naked flames
- Volume above L_{Amax} 70B(A) and L_{Cmax} 90dB(C) on Friday and Saturday and L_{Amax} 65 dB(A) and L_{Cmax} 85dB(C) from Sunday to Thursday.
- Decorations in water features (ponds and waterfalls)
- Adjusting the lighting and water features of the garden
- Smoking
- Littering
- Dangerous goods
- Illegal substances
